

## 3 Night 4 days Bhutan Tour

### Trip Overview

The exotic land of high mountains and amazing valleys, snowy peaks, and running springs filled with love and devotion for Lord Buddha, Bhutan, lies between India and Tibet in the eastern Himalayas. The country is less populated and less polluted. Bhutan has remained mysterious to the outer world. But now since the country has opened up to the world, there has been an increasing inflow of tourists from around the globe. However, the restriction on number remains. Once you step on this beautiful place, you will experience the serene ambiance and breath-taking sceneries.

This is the shortest tour guaranteed to fill you with an amazing experience. You land at Paro, where you can see the castle fortress at Rinpung, the national museum, and the 7th-century temple at Kurje. You can hike to Taktshang monastery (Tiger's Lair) which is worshipped by the entire Himalayan Buddhist world. Later, you visit Thimphu—the capital of Bhutan—where you can see amazing castle fortress at Tashi Chho Dzong monastery which holds the rich history of Buddhism in Bhutan. Then, you can experience places like Memorial Stupa, traditional paper factory, folk heritage museums, handicraft shops, and the world's biggest statue of Lord Buddha. You can explore the places and get stunned by the Bhutanese culture, people, language, traditions, histories, and artifacts. You will explore the beautiful place, [Bhutan](#), find yourself in a better place. You can visit Bhutan any time of the year, however, February to April and October to December is considered as the ideal time as the weather remains dry and pleasant throughout the tour.

### Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Paro

You will be picked from Paro airport, and transfer to Thimphu, Bhutan's capital. You will see a temple owned by Drubthob Thangtong Gyalpo inheritances. He had built numerous iron bridges in Bhutan. You can also see King's Memorial Chorten, National Zoo and Library, Folk Heritage Museum, and arts and crafts of Bhutan. Later, you can rest at your hotel in Thimphu.

Day 02: Paro Sightseeing{Paro Dzong (fortress), National Museum(Ta-Dzong), Dumshe Lhakhang, Kichu Lhakhang} OR Hiking to Taktsang Monastery (Tigers' nest) –Thimphu (60km/2hrs)

After an hour drive, you will visit Ta Dzong, a circular fortress that protected the valley, which is now a National Museum with Bhutanese significances. This place is called Dumshe Lhakhang, a temple built in 1433. Also, Mount Jumolhari (7314m), the sacred mountain, can be seen clearly. While coming back from Drugyel Dzong, you can visit Tigers' Nest base camp and Kitchu Monastery. Later, you can walk through Paro's shopping district and buy goods and textiles. O/N in hotel.

Day 03: Thimphu Sightseeing / Paro overnight (60km/2hrs)

In Thimphu, you will visit National Library to see Buddhist manuscripts and traditional medicine institute where healing arts such as acupuncture and homeopathy are practiced. Also, see Thangka painting, fine metal craft, weaving, paper making, and so on. You will visit Textile and Folk Heritage Museum which showcases Bhutanese material culture and traditions. Later, visit Tashichho Dzong, and then to Handicrafts Emporium and local shops to buy textiles, Thangka paintings, jewelry and so on. O/N at Paro.

Day 04: Departure

On this day, after breakfast, you will be leaving for your home country. Our team member will drop you at the airport before the flight time.
